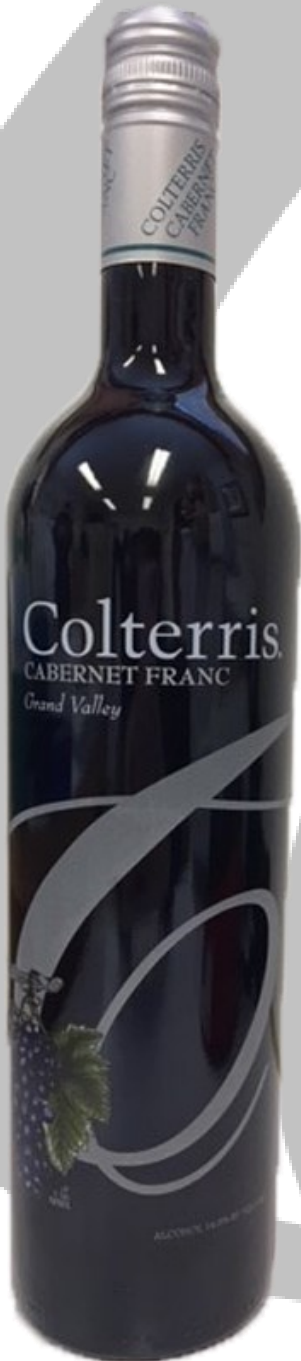


## COLTERRIS WINERY

*“from the Colorado land.”*

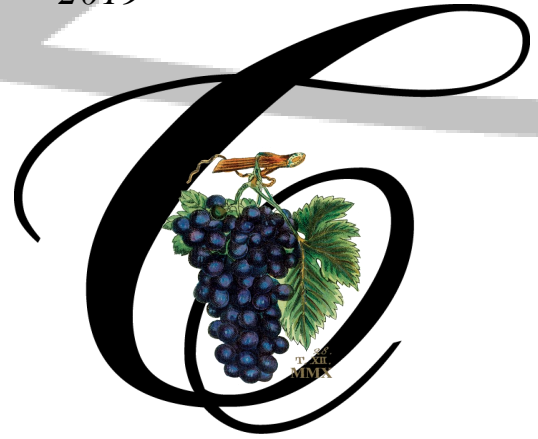

### WINEMAKER NOTES

True to form for Cabernet Franc, this wine displays an excellent fruit forward bouquet with subtle touches of roasted red pepper and dried herbs occasionally showing. On the palate the wine is very textural with the tannin profile being firm but well balanced. The preserved fruit notes and touch of leaf tobacco make this wine an excellent pairing for steaks, grilled chicken, lasagna, a variety of cheeses, grilled mushrooms and eggplant parmesan.

40% Katie's Vineyard Cabernet Franc , *Clone 1, Planted 1987*  
40% Riverside Vineyard Cabernet Franc , *Clone 1, Planted 1993*  
17.5% Scott's Vineyard Cabernet Franc , *Clones 4 & 12, Planted 2014*  
2.5% Scott's Vineyard Malbec , *Clone 4, Planted 2012*

### PRODUCTION NOTES

Having a naturally lower yield off Scott's Vineyard Cabernet Franc in 2019 means Katie's and Riverside are in higher concentration in the final blend. Both vineyard locations have excellent mature fruit with firm tannins making for a little bolder Cabernet Franc than normal! Aged 18 months in 15% new French oak barrels, balance in previously used barrels. Bottled 6/16-17/2021.
