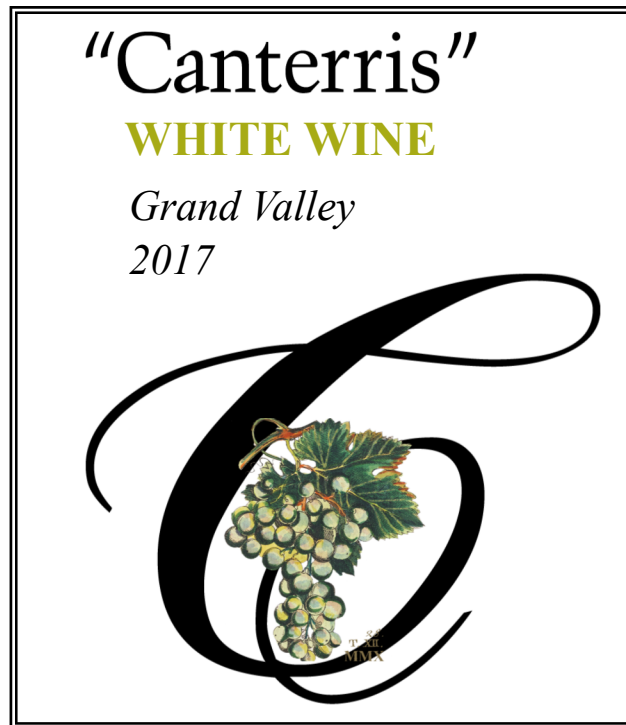


COLTERRIS WINERY

WINEMAKER NOTES

A blend of Pinot Gris, Chardonnay and Sauvignon Blanc, “Canterris” White Wine flashes stone fruit, white flower and citrus zest on the nose. On the palate, this easy-drinking white wine is smooth and refreshing and pairs great with a bike, a hike or a camping trip. Koozie advised!!

6% Riverside Vineyard Chardonnay, *Wente Clone, Planted 1991*
8% Cliffside Vineyard Sauvignon Blanc, *Clone 1, Planted 2003*

PRODUCTION NOTES

Canning wine presented a whole new set of challenges for the winemaking staff but using traditional winemaking techniques allowed us to create an easy-drinking white blend that’s perfect for the Colorado lifestyle. Using liquid nitrogen in the packaging process allows us to make a still wine without carbonation and still have integrity to our can.
