WINEMAKER NOTES

Concentrated dark, rich fruits dominate the aromatic profile of this wine with a touch of vanilla and green peppercorn in the background. Smooth and fruitful with subtle tannin and acid make this one of the best “porch sipping” reds in our portfolio! Pairs beautifully with a wide range of foods including Argentinian skirt steaks with chimichurri sauce, pineapple teriyaki salmon, slow-cooked braised brisket tostadas, spicy bean burgers, grilled mushroom caps, beef empanadas, fajitas, spaghetti Bolognese, and pepperoni pizza.

PRODUCTION NOTES

A synergistic blend of our three distinct Malbec vineyards yields a delightfully versatile fine red wine of increased depth and complexity, validating the notion that each vineyard site is unique and special in its own way! Oak barrel aged 17 months with 15% in new French Oak barrels. Bottled May 5 and 6, 2020. 935 cases produced.
