### WINEMAKER NOTES

Very fruitful aroma displays great red fruit notes. On the palate, this wine has a juicy roundness which delivers layers of fruitfulness and just a subtle spice character with velvety soft tannins.

28% Theresa's Vineyard Cabernet Sauvignon, *Mixed Clones, Planted 2001*  
20% Riverside Vineyard Cabernet Sauvignon, *Unknown Clone, Planted 1991*  
14% Two Brothers Vineyard Petit Verdot, *Clone ENT 400, Planted 2008*  
6% Riverside Vineyard Cabernet Sauvignon, *Clones 7&8, Planted 1998*

### PRODUCTION NOTES

The 2016 and 2017 Monumental Cabernet Sauvignon's were 100% Cabernet Sauvignon. Since the 2018 features The Devil's Kitchen on the label, we decided to dip into our pantry of ingredients and found the Two Brother's Petit Verdot to be a great compliment to the Cab, adding more juicy richness to the palate and another layer of complexity overall. Aged 24 months in oak barrels with 15% in new French oak barrels. Bottled 11/24/2020. 150 cases produced.
