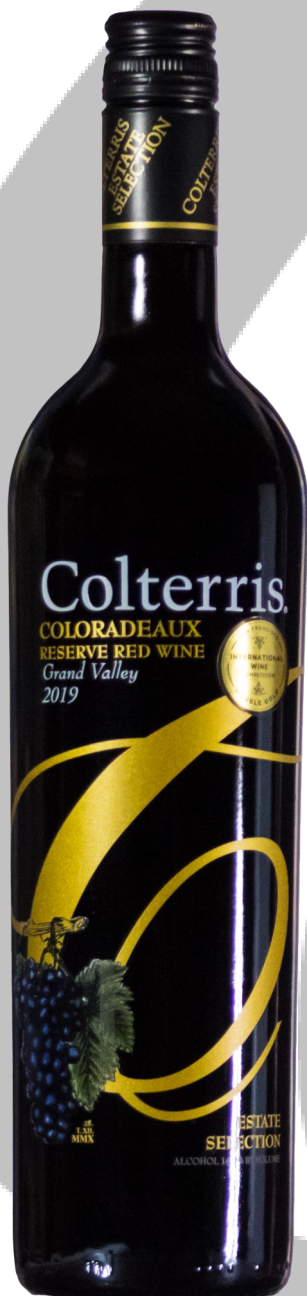


COLTERRIS WINERY

WINEMAKER NOTES

Fresh and concentrated fruit flavors are complemented by dark chocolate and caramel notes. The use of a higher percentage of new oak barrels adds to the textural elements without overpowering. In complimentary food pairings, this rich, robust red wine is perfect for a rich dishes such as braised beef or seared duck.

- 45.5% Riverside Vineyard Cab Sauvignon, Mixed Clones, planted 1991 & 1993
- 2% Vinelands Vineyard Merlot, Unknown Clone, planted 1999
- 22% Riverside Vineyard Merlot, Mixed Clones, planted 1991 & 1998
- 1.5% Theresa's Vineyard Merlot, Clone ENT 348 planted 2012
- 16.5% Riverside Vineyard Petit Verdot, Unknown Clone, planted 1991
- 3.5% Scott's Vineyard Cabernet Franc, Clones 4 & 12, planted 2014
- 2% Katie's Vineyard Malbec, Clone 9 planted 2011
- 2% Cliffside Vineyard Malbec, Clone 9 planted 2011
- 5% Scott's Vineyard Malbec, Clone 4 planted 2012

PRODUCTION NOTES

Even though the 2019 Grand Valley Coloradoaux wasn't overly tannic, we decided to pull some of our best barrels from the cellar and put a portion of the exact same blend we bottled in June of 2021 into those barrels and extend the aging another 6 months.

The wine is a testament to the barrels we select and use, because even at this high percentage of oak, we are still getting what I find to be a very terroir-driven wine elevated by oak, not overwhelmed by it. Aged 24 months in 77% new French oak.

Bottled 1/18/2022. 300 cases produced.
