## Plum Creek Wines



### Festival White

This bright and crisp white blend plays perfectly at any summer get together. On the nose, floral notes of lemongrass, pineapple, and honeydew. The palate presents a bright fruit forward notes of pear, apple, white peach, and pink grapefruit.



### 2023 Horse Mountain Riesling

The Horse Mountain Vineyard is a north-facing vineyard located approximately 3 miles south-west from Colterris Winery. The Riesling grapes grown on this vineyard reach maturity slower but retain acidity throughout the ripening period. This slow maturation makes this Riesling one of the last white wines of the annual harvest.



### 2023 Horse Mountain Syrah

The beautiful pepper notes from this Syrah bring life to any light meat dish. Ripe plums and soft blueberry notes help balance the medium body and acidity in this wine. Horse Mountain truly is a unique spot for making great wines in the Grand Valley and Colterris proud to keep the tradition.



### 2024 Cañon Grüner Veltliner

Great stone minerality followed by light citrus makes this wine perfect for any appetizer salad. The smooth body really compliments the light pear and cantaloupe aromatics as the wine moves through the palate. A white meat meal would find no better companion.



### Palisade® Rose

Notes of wild strawberry, cherry jam, watermelon, and rose flower. On the palate, this wine displays initial fruitfulness with bright acidity and hints of raspberry. Fruit forward and refreshing, this rosé is a delight for pools, patios, and picnics!



### Palisade® Red

A lighter style Bordeaux Red blend. In the glass, there are generous red fruit notes, especially raspberry, with a touch of vanilla and toasted oak in support. On the palate, the wine delivers more red fruit notes. A bright acid profile balances with the sweet fruit notes, while a layer of toasty oak brings complexity.
